### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

The judges decision is final.

There will be no registration for classes before the event.

No bitch in season is allowed to participate.

Participants are responsible for ensuring that their dog is healthy and fit to participate.

No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling in the ring or in the grounds.

No moves which may cause injury to the dog are allowed.

All dogs entered must be under control at all times.

A dog who has been in contact and/or in the vicinity of a dog with a contagious disease within 21 days of the show may not attend the show.

Please clear up after your dogs.

## DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS

### Show Schedule Notice

Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the following guidance will help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at Belvoir Lodge Fun Dog Show.

- When travelling to the show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams. The A52 can be quite busy at times.
- The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
- Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
- When at the show, never leave your dog in a locked vehicle. If you intend to leave a dog(s) in a vehicle please let the marshalls know as you arrive and they will park you in the most suitable place.
- Keep the dog in the shade, there is plenty of shade available in the Gardens but the sun does move round so please bring your own shade, for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated. The water in the fountains is okay for the dogs to drink so they can help themselves.
- Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

**Warning: if your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.**

**Right to refuse entries.** Exhibitors/competitors are reminded that the organisers have the right to refuse any entry.

“A dog docked on or after the 6th April 2007 may not be entered for competition at this show.”
